Participating Store	A participating store is any in-store and online Coles Liquor retailer (namely Liquorland, First Choice Liquor Market and Vintage Cellars) located in Australia that stocks Aperol products and displays advertising material for this promotion (“ Participating Store ”).
Promotional Period	The Promotion commences on 16 October 2024 and closes for entries at 11:59pm AEDT on 12 November 2024 (“ Promotion Period ”).
Eligible Entrants	Entry is open to Australian residents only aged 18 years or over. Employees (and their immediate families) of the Promoter, its related entities, Participating Stores, any prize drawers and any agencies associated with this Promotion are ineligible to enter. Immediate family means any of the following: spouse, ex-spouse, de-facto spouse, child or step-child (whether natural or by adoption), parent, step-parent, grandparent, step-grandparent, uncle, aunt, niece, nephew, brother, sister, step-brother, step-sister or 1 st cousin.

There will be one (1) draw for this promotion for all entries received during the Promotional Period.</p> <p>The draw will take place at Greeneagle Distribution & Fulfilment, 5/9 Fitzpatrick Street, Revesby NSW 2212 on 19 November 2024 at 1:00pm AEDT. The Promoter may draw additional reserve entries and record them in order in case an invalid entry or ineligible entrant is drawn.</p> <p>5. The Promoter may at any time (including after the Promotional Period), verify the validity of entries and entrants and reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any individual who the Promoter reasonably believes has breached any of these terms, tampered with the entry process or engaged in any unlawful or other improper misconduct calculated to jeopardise fair and proper conduct of the Promotion. Errors and omissions may be accepted at the Promoter's discretion. Failure by the Promoter to enforce any of its rights at any stage does not constitute a waiver of those rights. Prize includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Return economy airfares between the winner's closest capital city and Melbourne, Victoria for the winner and one (1) adult travel companion; • Return private airport/accommodation transfers for two (2) people in the destination city; • Two (2) nights' accommodation at Rydges Hotel Melbourne (twin/double); • Two (2) tickets to the Australian Open Men's Final on Sunday 26 January 2025, including AO Glasshouse dining experience; and • \$500 spending money (winner only) in the form of an Eftpos gift card. <p>8.
